neighbourhood locality and various regular college activities. The primary purpose of the event which was to bring back the students to college campus was immensely fulfilled.

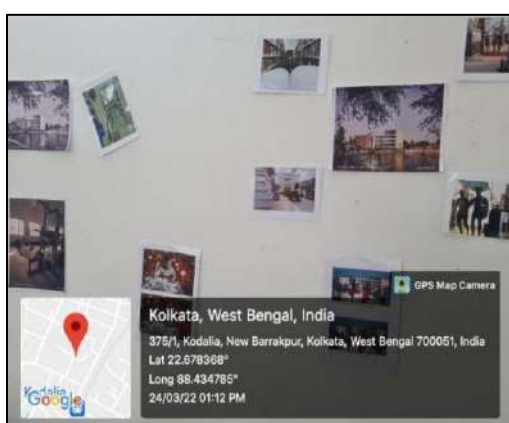

8. Outcome of the programme

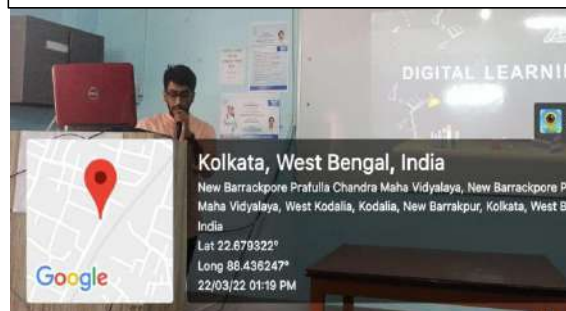

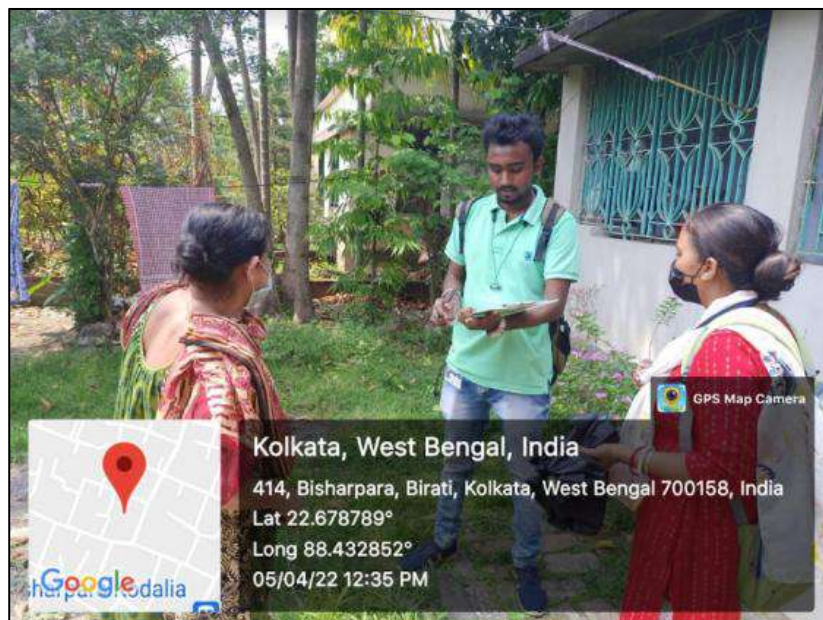
6. Brief Description

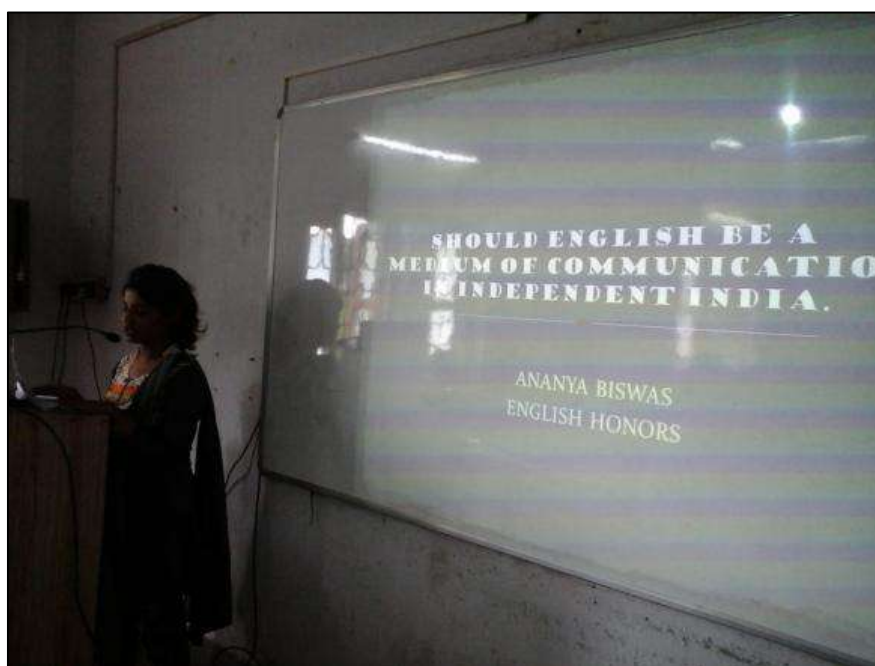

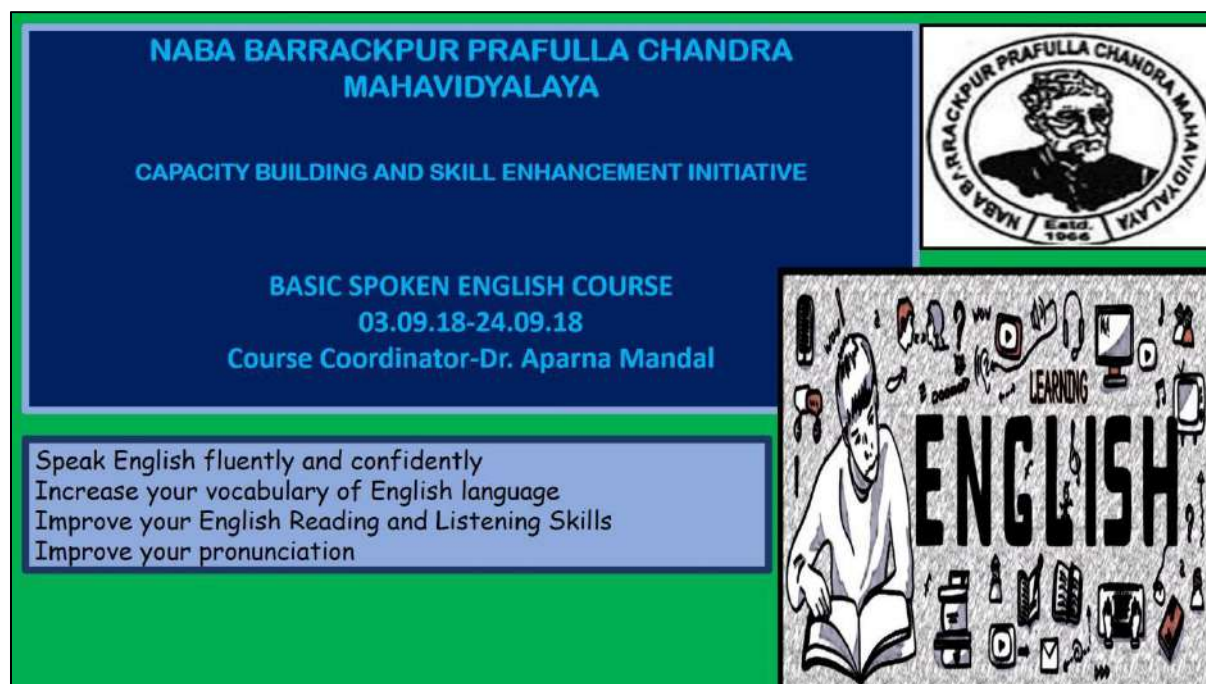

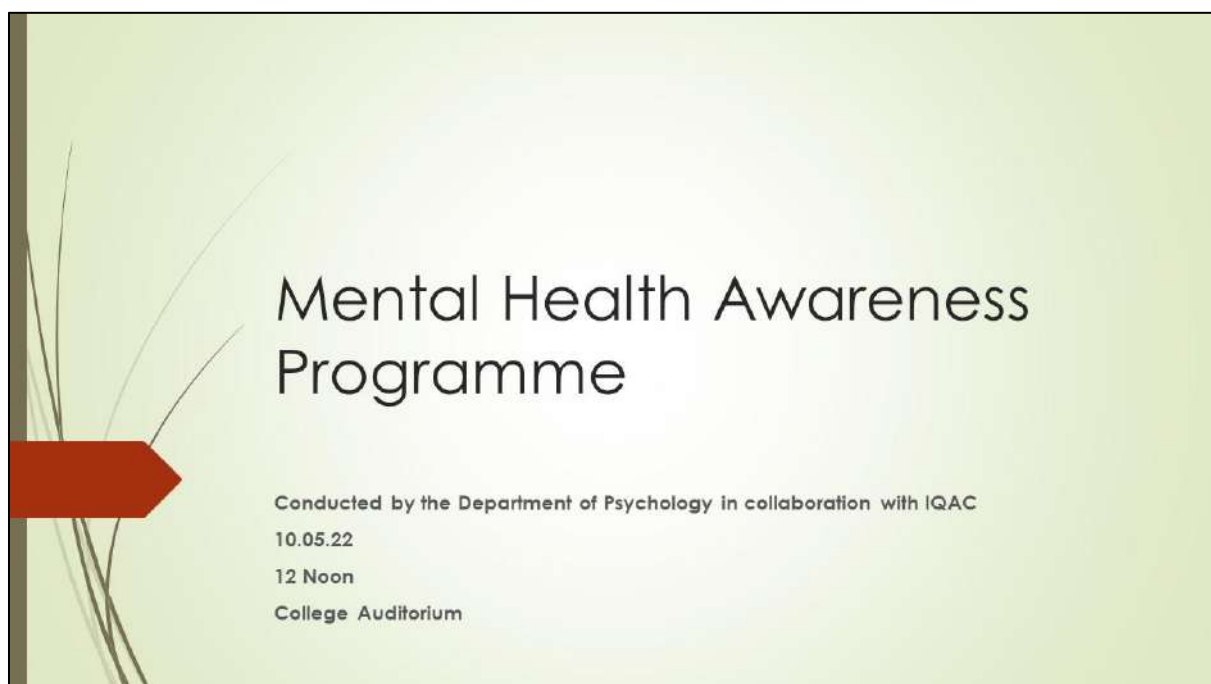
